## Comments Report

## 5. Open Ended

5.1) The instructor (please comment on questions 4.1-4.5 above)

- Class time was always used well. It definitely helped to come to class because we spoke Spanish during the entire class. Also, Melissa is extremely passionate about the Spanish language and our class, which motivated me throughout the semester and made learning easier.
- Melissa is wonderful. By far the best Spanish teacher I've ever had. She really helped us through the grammar parts that we were stuck on and had good discussion questions for the assigned readings. She was always enthusiastic and tried to relate to us as people, not just as her students.
- Melissa was my favorite professor by far this semester. She inspired me to change my major to Spanish and study abroad in Mexico next semester. I wasn't sure what to expect of Spanish professors at OU and thought things would be similar to high school however Melissa far over exceeded these preconceptions and challenged me daily in Spanish. The energy of the class was great and everyday Melissa was ready to teach and excite students about Spanish. I wish I could take another Melissa class next semester because I think she is the perfect fit for my learning style but I know I'll have to wait until another semester. Melissa was also always ready to help and always had her door open whether or not she had office hours or not.
- My instructor was amazing. She was very enthusiastic whole teaching, which made it easier to learn and pay attention. Class was never boring and felt like it always flew by.
- Professor Figueroa was wonderful. She was always so helpful and always willing to spend extra time with me. I really enjoyed the class because of her and I'm now attempting a minor because she encouraged me too.
- She was a very enthusiastic teacher who motivated us to learn and was very reasonable when we didn't understand what she was saying in Spanish. If we were all really confused she would explain in English so we knew what was expected of us.
- She was always on time and excited when she walked into the classroom. Willing to put in extra time to make sure everyone really understood what was going on and if you needed help she was available either through email or office hours. I really appreciated how flexible she was because it enable me to get the most out of the class.
- She was always very enthusiastic and wanted us to be excited, too. She was very considerate when it came to other classes and was willing to make accommodations. 5.2) The course and the materials (please comment on questions 4.6-4.10 above)

- Overall, the course curriculum was good. I feel as though the online component of the book (Supersite) didn't really help my learning that much. I found that more often than not, I would just guess at the answers and not actually learn the material.
- Supersite was not the best because of small mistakes catching you up but still was useful and challenging. I enjoyed the book and thought it was great for the course, wish it could be cheaper though.
- The VHL online homework could be a little tedious sometimes but overall I believe it helped me to learn the material and understand the lessons better.
- The course in general was fairly difficult for me because I only had 4 years in highschool. It seemed like a few kids in my class had been on exchanges and knew the language more than me. This was pretty intimidating at times.
- The course material was a good balance of complicated and easy. The homework was often tedious but class time helped cover the confusing aspects of the homework that was given.
- The online assignments were helpful, but I think the time they were due should be changed. Most online homework for classes is due either midnight the night before or midnight the day of class. If we were able to go to class and learn the material then do the homework I think it would be more beneficial. The textbook was okay, but I do not believe it explained the material well. There was a large amount of case by case examples instead of a general formula to learn the material.
- The readings in the book were extremely difficult, with almost every word being annotated. It became very hard to try to read through the story when you didn't know what was going on because you had to look up the word. Supersite was also difficult, as it would take off points for small mistakes. I really liked the handouts in class that the professor had made for us. They helped me understand much better.
- This class did not help me learn much language, but the homework was effective and the exams were challenging, but also a reward to the students if they studied. I believe that since this is a 3000 course, it was different to learn because so much information is already taught before this class. This left for a lot of review.
- This course is great because it's actually applying the language to everyday life.
