She used class time well and provided us with many activities that engaged us with our classmates and helped us improve our proficiency in the language. I especially appreciated the fact that she conducted the class in Spanish 99% of the time, as I signed up for a language class and I believe that, especially at this level, I should be nearing proficiency in the language. Melissa's class has grown my appreciation and interest in the language and culture and, largely because of her class and influence, I will be minoring in Spanish. I appreciated her feedback that was given in a timely manner and her availability to talk. 5.2) The course and the materials (please comment on questions 4.6-4.10 above)

- Appropriate, although rushed and oftentimes skipped over.
- Book and video assignments are helpful, but some of the connect assignments are frustrating to use.
- Challenging
- Connect does not help.
- Connect sucks big time and is the reason i will have a poor grade. Total waste of time, homework needs to be from the book or developed by the teacher to better suit the classes needs.
- I find the course to be challenging, but I also find Spanish in general to be difficult especially when learning a language in college. The materials helped but some assignments seem more as busy work and don't really seem to be that important in learning a language (some stories in text) (poem that did more confusing than helping)
- I only take Spanish because it is required for my major and so I never liked coming to class or doing the homework but it was a reasonable work load.
- I was constantly doing Spanish homework. It became a thing with my friends that whenever I was working they assumed it was Spanish, which was constantly. It certainly helped me improve my language skills, but I noticed that it made me not want to learn Spanish at all occasionally.
- Learnsmarts were a pain because of the 6am due date which was required to be finished before we even learned the material in class
- The book does not help.
- The connect was occasionally helpful but for he most part I would have liked more book exercises or take home materials
- The course and the materials were challenging but not too difficult. I feel like I got a better understanding of the Spanish culture through videos and reading assignments that were interesting to watch and read and learn about.
- The course material that Melissa had us do in class was super beneficial and helped my language skills tremendously. The assignments did help me learn the language, although I would not recommend Connect as all it really did was create frustration. I would say that the use of Connect did not improve my language skills. I would like to point out, however, that this is not by any means Melissa's doing. She remained encouraging and understanding with the many technical difficulties experienced with Connect.
- The course materials helped increase my skills by making me practice. The exercises in the book were challenging but useful. The explanations are very good in the book. The connect homework was a little too hard but still useful to help me learn.
- The course was fun, learned more about culture and language
- The exams and assignments that she gave were appropriately challenging and well put together. The only thing I did not like were the Connect homework assignments. This is because in many situations, there are more than one right answer, but the program only counts one specific answer as being correct.

- The materials seemed appropriate for the course if not tedious at times. All of the written and video assignments were relevant and contributed to understanding of the course work. However, some of the connect assignments were quite repetitive and just seemed like busy work. The instructor had no control over the connect assignments though so I understand that Professor Figueroa didn't really have much to do with Connect.
- This was something worth-while to learn but the connect assignments rarely helped me learn anything. The instructions were frequently unclear and it involved a lot of guessing. The first time around if I had no idea what I was doing. The exams were difficult and were also sometimes unclear on what was expected of us.



## 5.3) Self-Evaluation (please comment on questions 4.11-4.13 above)
