Comments Report

5. Open Ended

5.1) The instructor (please comment on questions 4.1-4.7 above)

- Melissa has been a fantastic instructor. I was very nervous to be in a class about Spanish Literature again, especially given the time period and that none of it was contemporary. However, she did a great job of making the material interesting and not overwhelming. Very highly rated!
- Melissa is always very enthusiastic about this class. She created a classroom environment conducive to learning. She genuinely cares about the success of her students and is willing to work with students when they have difficulties with the course.
- Melissa was a fantastic professor! She was always happy and enthusiastic in class and was always making sure that we were all on the same page with the class topic. She always made sure her way of teaching was communicated clearly to us. I enjoyed coming to her class!
- Professor Figueroa was a great professor who was very passionate about the course material. She would get very excited about certain passages and engage the class which made it more exciting to learn. She also used class time very well and never cancelled.
- She is great! The class was so interesting and engaging. Use of Spanish the whole time - which was nice for both native and non-native speakers. She treated us like we were her peers, and that created a very nice and welcoming environment in the classroom. She is so helpful and always made herself available outside of the classroom. She put a lot into the class, it was obvious. She invited several people from other departments to help us understand from different perspectives the subjects that we were working on in class. Thanks, this was great!
- She's really good at encouraging us to read and comprehend the plays. The class seemed intimidating at first, but she does a really good job of making sure we aren't going too fast or overwhelmed. She's really nice and supportive, and understands that sometimes things come up, which makes it much easier to stay caught up in the class.
- The instructor created an encouraging learning environment. She pushed students to participate without pushing them into nervousness by leading by example and lending help. She doesn't give up on her students. She is understanding and forgiving, but still insists that students get through and learn the material by some reasonable means.
- The instructor was always in a good mood, funny, easy to talk to. She also knew what she was talking about when it came to the course material, and her in class presentations and questions with group work were really effective in helping me understand the course material.
- The instructor was amazing with feedback, it was timely as well as useful. She corrected things that interfered with the understanding, not just everything she thinks I should've worded differently.

5.2) The course and the materials (please comment on questions 4.8-4.10 above)

- Appropriately challenging. I might suggest one less play as we covered a lot of material throughout the semester
- Guest speakers were very interesting.
- I would recommend this course for Spanish students because it allows you to study more than just grammar. I have never been very interested in theater but Professor Figueroa made it interesting.
- The course and the materials were compelling, well chosen, and she knew her material very well. Sometimes I have a hard time reading in the format of plays and following along, but even though I was reading 500 year old stuff in my second language, it was still manageable
- The course and the materials were incredibly useful for vocabulary expansion and listening to a Puerto Rican accent helped me to better understand native speakers. I feel like instead of learning from busy work, I had a nice experience learning by reading and discussing constantly in class. I feel like that allowed us to have a more practical understanding of the language because we constantly engaged in discourse which made me learn new terms quickly.
- The course was challenging in the same way it's challenging to analyze a Shakespeare play. Not something I'm used to but the plays in general were interesting and fun to read and discuss.
- The course was really interesting! I did not know about some of these pieces of literature, and so it was really interesting for me to learn about this part of Spanish culture and literary time.
- The course was very interesting. I do not think I would have had interest in this if it had not been for how Melissa conveyed the information and made it relevant to us. The materials used were useful and helpful
- The plays were all challenging without being impossible, and the questions she gave us made us really discuss what the play was about. She also had people that are actually involved with aspects of drama come in and talk to us, which really made the plays feel like they had a real world connection.
