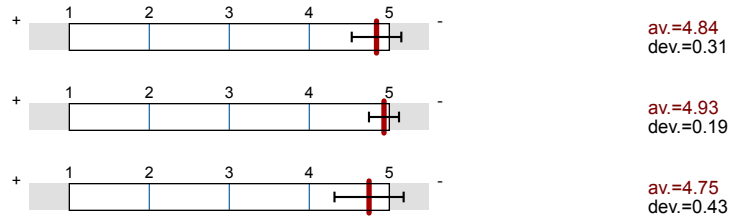

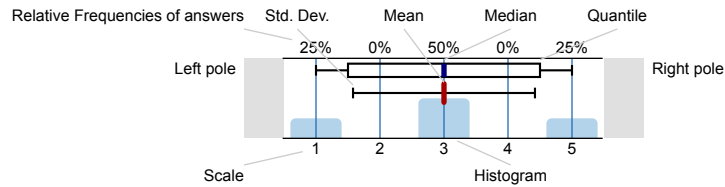

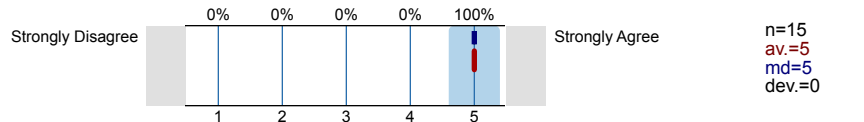

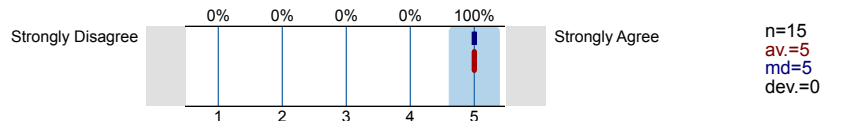

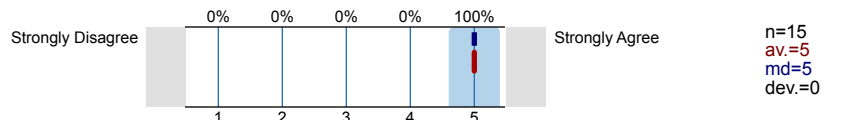

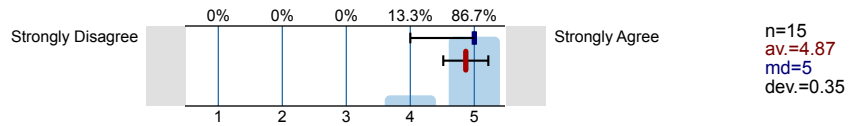

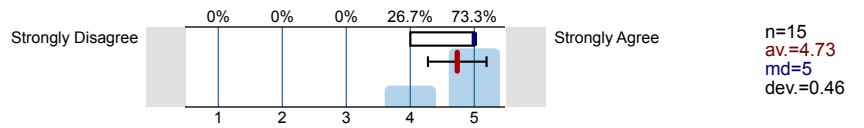

5. Open Ended

5.1) The instructor (please comment on questions 4.1-4.7 above)

5.2) The course and the materials (please comment on questions 4.8-4.10 above)

- At first, I was skeptical about the overall structure, but I came to appreciate the text because of its ease of reading. I would suggest focusing on more analysis in future iterations of the course.
- I thought the homeworks were helpful, they incorporated spanish into fun activities that we could do from home and they always helped me understand the material well. I also like the questions for the reading because it helps me know exactly what I'm supposed to be looking for and pick out the important information.
- It got repetitive at times BUT it was nice knowing what we were expected to do (because of the class guides).
- Sometimes the course seemed a little bit redundant as each class had the same format (for the most part), more activities within class could have changed things up.
- The course is a lot of discussion, which is helpful in a sense, but I learn a lot through professors' lectures and stories.
- The course materials were interesting and encouraged me to want to learn about Spain and its culture.
- The course was appropriately challenging, the instructor provided great feedback and actually cared about her students. I enjoyed using technology to learn more about the course.
- The course was very interesting. I found it to be challenging and it covered a lot of different subjects

- This class was challenging, but I never felt overwhelmed with the content. It was the right amount of difficult to push me, but not too tough that I ever felt like I couldn't be successful.
