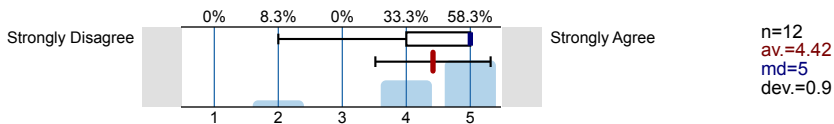

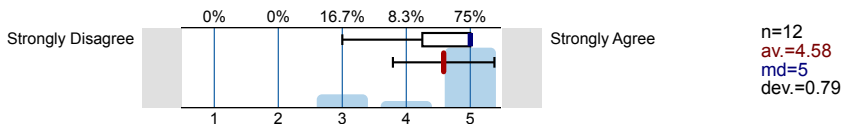

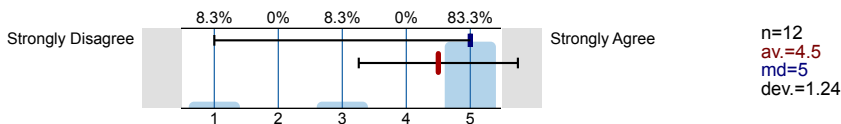

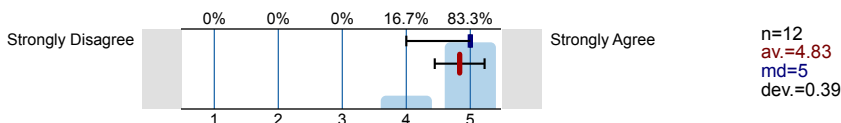

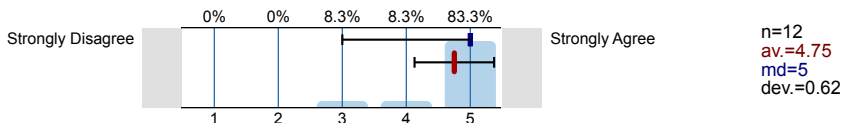

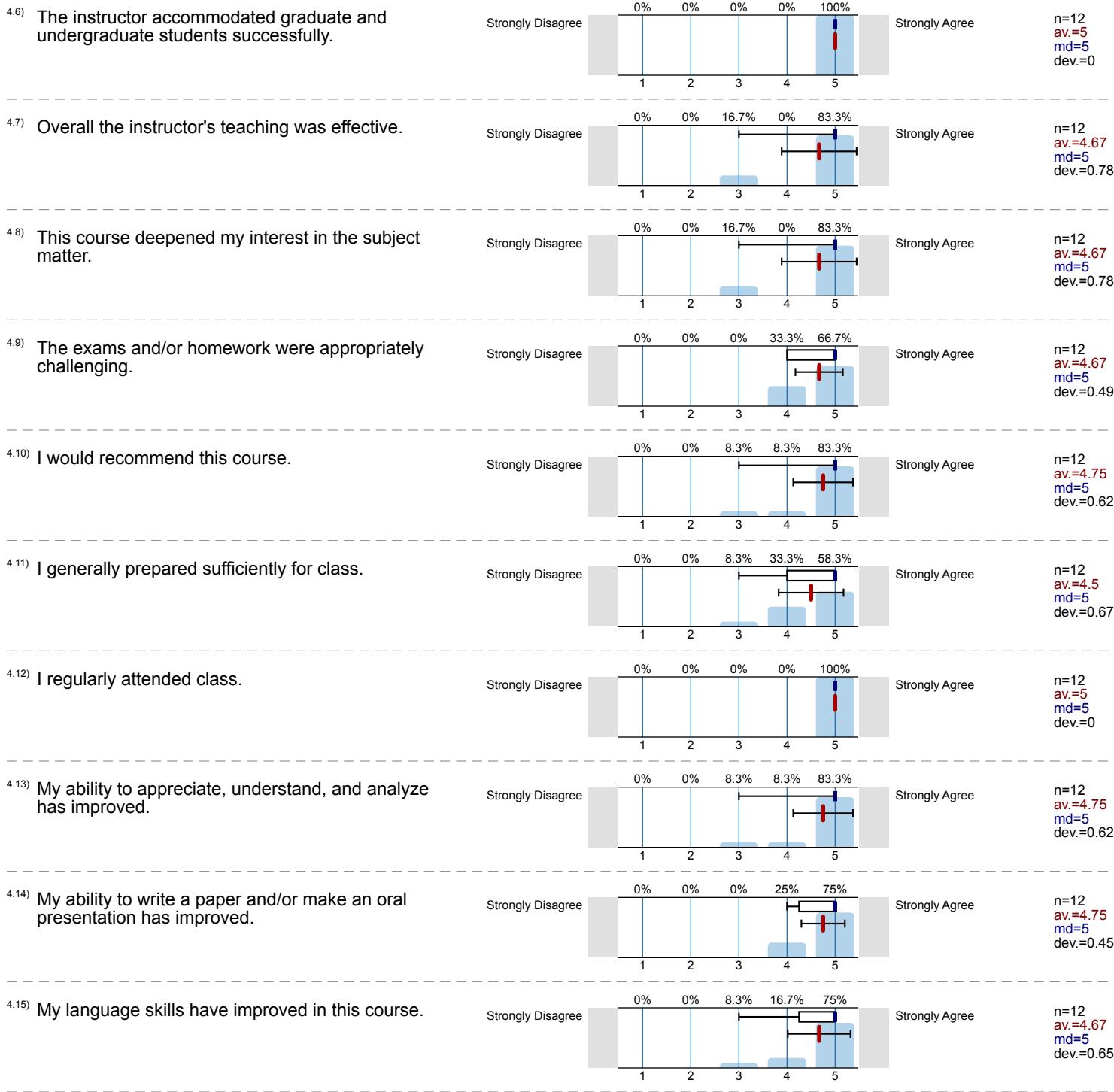


4.4) The instructor showed enthusiasm when teaching.

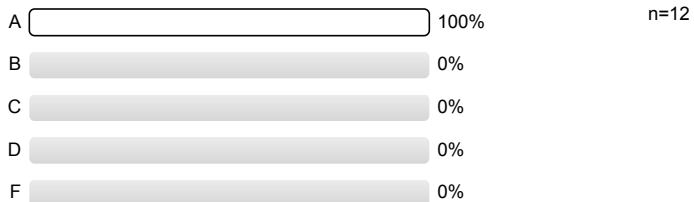

Comments Report

5. Open Ended

5.1) The instructor (please comment on questions 4.1-4.7 above)

- Dra. Figueroa is probably one of the most motivating and enthusiastic professors I have ever had. She has succeeded in significantly increasing my interest on this subject. What I appreciated the most about Dra. Figueroa was her great moral support at any time, being always available for us, even if it was outside her office hours. She has succeeded in increasing our self esteem in general. Also, Dra. Figueroa has always shared with us very interesting knowledge that has helped us a lot to understand the material.
- I think the professor should have given us more feedback during the presentations. The classes were taught by the students and just in few instances, she offered some theory background or feedback. It would have been nice if she had shared her knowledge with us. Also, I think she should not have asked us to lie about classes or e-mails. That made some of us feel uncomfortable and it sounded unprofessional. In addition, I think she should not have shown us what she was going to say about us at the teachers' meeting. This attitude can be interpreted negatively and cause discomfort. In the syllabus, there is a section about using the student's materials for conferences as evidence of her professional development. I think that we should be able to decide that at the end of the semester with a professional letter given by her to us that we either sign giving permission or we do not.
- I wish I had more opportunities to listen to my teacher explaining and sharing all the knowledge that she has. I enjoyed listening to my classmates however she could contribute a little bit more. Every time that the teacher explained something was enlightening.
- She was always available and open for all of us.
- She's great! Always available to help or answer questions when needed.
- The instructor encouraged us to think and work independently, but nevertheless guided the course of the class. She always made herself available for questions. She was super accommodating of the needs of all students. Her knowledge of the subject was excellent. I couldn't recommend the professor enough, she was great.
- The instructor gave us freedom to lead each discussion. That way, we benefit from each other's analysis.
- The instructor seems to know a lot about the subject. But the seminar setting did not foster learning. We barely know about Golden Age in Spanish Literature, and I believe this class should have covered it in a deeper way.
- The instructor was always available for us in case we needed anything, motivated me in my pursuits and guided me, helping me to become a better grad student. She strongly promoted independent and critical thinking and for this I am very grateful, as I have learned much from Melissa, as a professor, and as a person.
- The instructor was very flexible and understanding both in and outside class and showed a great concern for her students at all times.
- The instructor, Dr. Melissa Figueroa, has ALWAYS been totally available when I wanted to talk about my grades, my progress and my academic performance. She would always encourage me to go to her office hours and she constantly provided EXTRA office hours. She is extremely professional and respectful. To be honest, Melissa Figueroa is the BEST professor I have ever had. Plus, I cannot imagine a person who knows more about Golden Age Literature than she does. I am so so lucky to have had her as a professor.
- There was a solid amount of learning that came from this course. It was both challenging and rewarding and it was all facilitated by the professor, allowing us to think for ourselves and express our analyses.

5.2) The course and the materials (please comment on questions 4.8-4.10 above)

- Don Quijote de la Mancha and the texts that study Cervante's work were very interesting and challenging.
- Don Quixote (SPAN 5558) has been very well designed. Every student had to orally present at least twice on a selection of chapters of this novel, provided by her. There have been three written tests, that were absolutely adjusted to the topics covered in class, which she explained very well and she made sure everybody understood the complex themes in Golden Age Literature and Don Quixote.
- I believe the way the class was structured allowed us to read the whole book and analyze the most important aspect of each chapter. I would definitely recommend this class.
- I think the format was suitably independent for graduate class. It challenged us to work. I don't think I would change anything.
- I would like the course to include perhaps more material on Goldenage Spain and the historical context of the Novel, since it is a very interesting period which cannot be covered in a single class,
- The course was interesting but we explored a limited amount of topics as there was no deeper guidance from the professor. Maybe if the format of the course had been different, I could have learned more about the subject.
- The material was effective and related to subject.
- The workshops to learn how to better write papers were very helpful. I liked the course overall and I think flipped learning can be very beneficial, but at some times it might have been a little overwhelming with the amount of presentations. Having said that, I did find the course very enlightening and I learned very much.
- There was variety in the exams and the idea of presenting every day to the whole class provided a unique challenge to TA's who are normally used to a slightly different type of teaching.
- This course was designed as a seminar, all the materials were understandable and they satisfied the main goal of our class.

5.3) Self-Evaluation (please comment on questions 4.11-4.16 above)

- I feel like I did not learn anything new. I only read the book (Don Quijote de la Mancha) and I have listened to my peers presentations. I wish the instructor had lecture more.
- I likely could have benefited from better in-class preparation.
- I never thought it would be possible to read this book and to analyze its content. However, I believe I should improve my analysis.
- I read in advance to each class and prepared many chapters in advance, especially for my expositions.
- I read throughout the semester and actively participated in the class. Perhaps I should have tried harder to reinforce the interpretation that each person made and presented in class.
- I think I did very good in this class, mostly because of the motivation that Dr. Melissa Figueroa provided us.
- I tried to give the best I could and I was always involved with the class and the activities as well as the assignments.
- I would like that my final grade reflects my overall performance of the semester.
