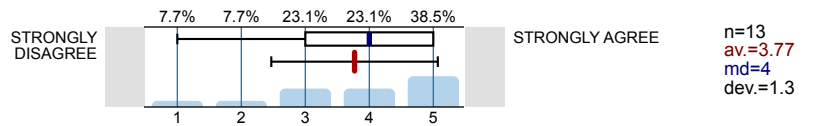

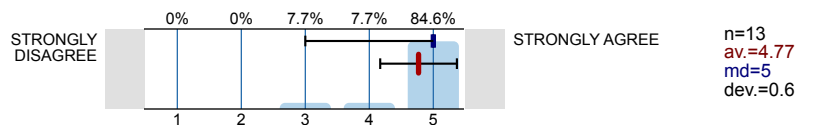

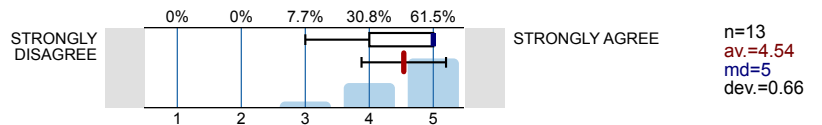

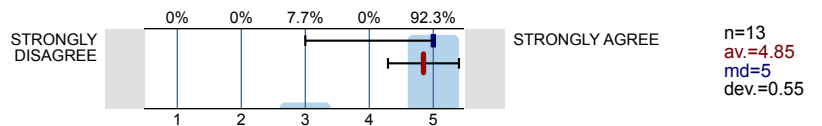

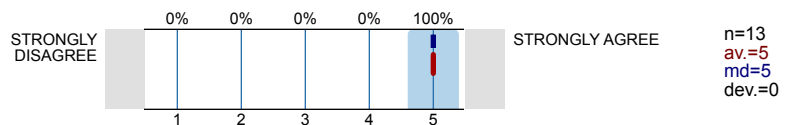

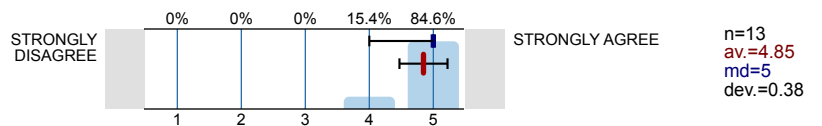

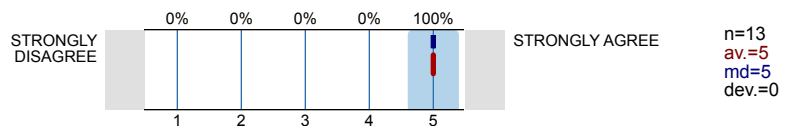
4.2) The instructor showed enthusiasm when teaching?



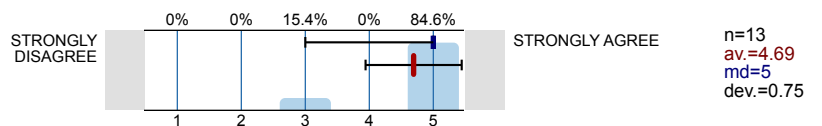

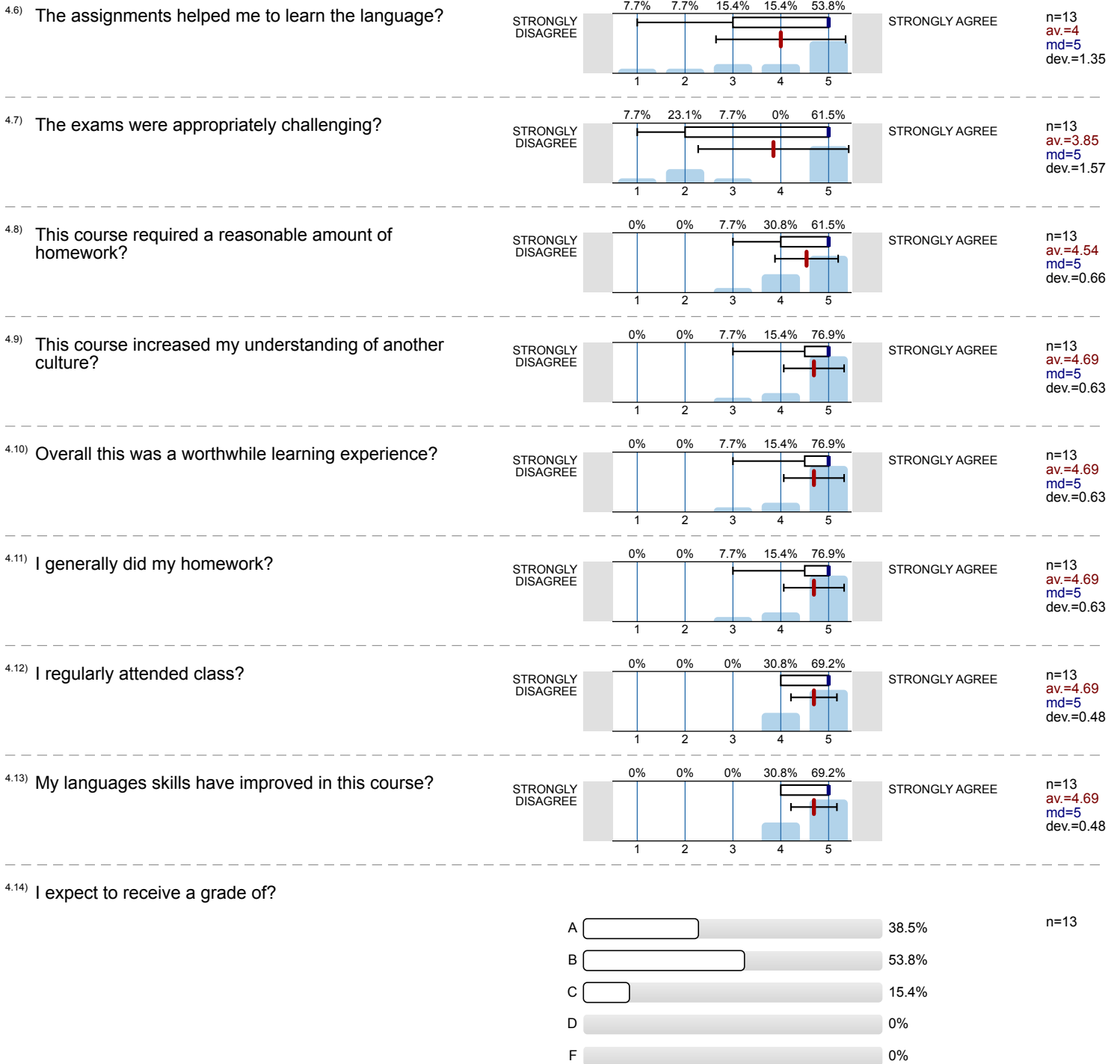

Comments Report

5. Open Ended

^{5.1)} The instructor (please comment on questions 4.1-4.5 above)

- Melissa is fantastic! She is very enthusiastic about teaching and about her students. Her communication and feedback on assignments is very timely and helpful to improve upon. She is always available outside of class and continuously encourages us to utilize her office hours.
- Professor Figueroa was very enthusiastic in class and had very effective teaching methods. She conducted the class only in Spanish and she made sure everyone was on track during group work by walking around the classroom, making sure we only spoke in Spanish, and asking us if we understood or if we had any questions.
- She was very enthusiastic about teaching with an obvious passion for the language/culture. Not only did this make the class more enjoyable but caused me to want to pay even more attention.
- Sometimes the speed of the lecture was overwhelming. It was hard to understand the activities without more explanation. The tests were extremely difficult to complete in the short amount of time.
- The instructor always showed up enthusiastic and ready to teach. She encouraged us to only speak in Spanish once we entered the classroom and even though it was tough it helped me to think in Spanish. I really appreciated the notes that she gave on our essays especially.
- The instructor of this course was very enthusiastic when it came to teaching and offered help when needed. Overall, I feel that she did a good job at teaching this course.
- The instructor was extremely useful and did her best to teach the material. She was very enthusiastic and open about the course, making sure to allow time for questions. I have no complaints; she was great.
- The instructor was very enthusiastic about the language and being able to teach it to us. The fact that she was so excited about the language made me motivated to learn. The entire class is spoken in the language, which allows us to practice our speaking but is sometimes difficult understanding instructions and being able to talk about the material, if it is difficult to understand the reasons behind the language.

5.2) The course and the materials (please comment on questions 4.6-4.10 above)

- I feel the essays and exams are very helpful. Melissa does a great job preparing us for those. The Supersite is not overly useful, but it's good practice. The textbook itself can be difficult to follow. Much of the information presented, both in English and Spanish, is not well explained within the text. This causes difficulties with the Supersite as it directly follows the text.
- I had difficulty with some of the super site homework. Sometimes I felt that the textbook didn't adequately prepare me for the homework. Fortunately things then made sense when we went over it in class.
- Maybe a little too advanced, even for a 3000 level. There were many lessons I did not understand
- Sometimes the explanations/readings in the book were a little confusing, so having to go to class the next day and use it was a bit difficult. The exams allowed us to show fully our understanding of the language and how to use it. The only problem with the exams is that there are so many questions and about the same amount of time to answer them. This is difficult if you have to manually put in the accents, which also takes up time. The cultural presentations about other countries increased my interest and understanding of not only the Spanish cultural, but the differences between the Spanish-speaking countries.
- The course and materials seemed to just go side by side with the topics we discussed.
- The course and materials were challenging, but I learned a lot and my Spanish has improved greatly.
- The course itself was pretty challenging. I found the exams to be too long and challenging for the time given to take them and the book was not always helpful.
- The course required a reasonable amount of homework; it was due 3 times a week before class. I appreciated that we had to learn by ourselves, but I would have liked for her to go over the homework content in class before it was due, so the homework would be practice. Overall, I learned a lot in this class and I appreciate her teaching methods.
- The course was ok, and the online content was acceptable. I wouldn't say anything was especially good, it was standard.
- The exams were to long for the time allotted as well as the homework assignment were very confusing, with unclear instructions
- The supersite for homework was difficult for certain activities and the book didn't explain things as well as it could've
- were difficult but manageable. The class overall worked at a quick pace allowing for an effective review of the language

5.3) Self-Evaluation (please comment on questions 4.11-4.13 above)

- I always did my homework and tried my best on assignments. I need to work on communicating in class more.
- I believe I could have done a lot better throughout this course if I had more time on the exams and a more helpful text. I think I learned a significant amount of Spanish but it does not show through my grade.
- I did all homework on time and turned in all assignments, but I'm not sure how much I am actually retaining
- I did all of the homework to the best of my ability and in a timely manner. I attended class as much as I could, but personal reasons sometimes prevented me from attending class. This contributes to my grade in the class. I expected to do better in this course based on my previous knowledge of the Spanish language, however, the additional information is important to the language, although it is sometimes difficult to apply.
- I did everything I was supposed to, but I still felt unprepared
- I did not put as much effort as I could have in this class, but this is not fault of the professor.
- I generally would say this class gives a useful courseload that aids in the understanding of the Spanish language.
- I have missed a few classes, but have tried to study more outside of class to make-up for that.
- I missed class 3 times, and I always did my homework. Because of this, my language skills have improved a lot.
- I would take the class again
- My writing skills in particular improved in this class. I still struggle with listening and responding in Spanish but I think I just need more practice.
