5. Open Ended

^{5.1)} The instructor (please comment on questions 4.1-4.7 above)

- I like the text book for this course because it contains a collaboration of many different works. We read short stories, plays, and poems. I like the variety in the literature that the text book contains.
- The book was hard to get access to but she never hesitated to let students borrow her version to complete readings
- The course material was definitely very interesting. I have read some of the pieces that we read in class, but this time I learned how to analyze them differently. I was able to learn more about Spanish literature and love it very much (but not as much as Doctor Figueroa). The assignments always helped me understand the course more seeing as they led into class discussion and essays that we would write too. Without a doubt I would recommend this course (and I already have).
- The course was interesting considering I knew nothing about Spanish age literature before now. I feel like I have a solid understanding of themes and prose during this time period.
- The coursework overall was pretty challenging, and I found most of it to be pretty engaging. The class's content would work better if it weren't for time, yet I still feel like I've been able to expand on my language skills from studying the material so far.
- The materials were quite challenging. Medieval Spanish is different than modern Spanish, which made them difficult to read. It would've been more helpful if the instructor gave a quick run through on the differences at the beginning of the semester; I would've understood the materials better if she had done that.
- This course is hard and I took it to challenge me. I think reading old Spanish literature is important because it tells us about society back then

5.3) Self-Evaluation (please comment on questions 4.11-4.16 above)

- As a senior, I believe my writing and speaking abilities have increased from this course. I feel confident in my abilities. I regularly attended class, did the readings, and was motivated to go beyond if I felt I needed some extra help in understanding some of the texts.
- I attended class on a regular basis and I could have prepared more with the readings, but overall I still feel like I have a solid understanding of the subject matter now.
- I could have prepared better by reading the material more in depth before class. The small quizzes due before each class helped me read, but I still could have been more thorough.
- I could have tried harder in this class. Taken more time to understand the readings better to better contribute in class
- I think i could have prepared for class more but I didn't have the book so sometimes I couldn't prepare but that was my own fault
- Personally, this class would be much more successful for me if it wasn't at 9:00. Sometimes I think the only thing lacking in this course overall is the discussion between students, which is hard to maintain so early in the morning.
- Professor Figueroa took attendance every day and those points count toward our grade, so I was motivated to come to class. The papers we had to write in the class helped me improve my Spanish writing skills and also analyzation skills.
- There were times where I would not understand the texts so I would use summaries, which are great for understanding the overall meaning of the text, but not specifics. However, in class, these doubts were clarified. I have never missed one of these classes and participate in them as well. My language and writing is already good (I am a native Spanish speaker), but this course has taught me more about analyzing rather than grammar and conversation.
