I am always motivated to learn because I know she wants me to succeed. Everything is taught in Spanish which is challenging but also improves my listening skills. Melissa is a wonderful teacher. She is always asking if we have any questions and encourages us to go to her office hours for more help. She is also very dedicated. She revises all of our essays and homework to let us know how we did. I would love to have her again.
- Melissa was an extremely enthusiastic teacher that truly showed she cared about me. She spoke only in Spanish unless she needs to explain a complex subject and truly helped me improve on my own skills.

- It was definitely a worthwhile experience and there was just the right amount of work.
- Some online assignments, weren't helpful in learning the subject on VHL, but rather time consuming.
- The VHL assignments didn't help me too much. They covered too many different topics at once, so I had trouble with them. However, the tareas and essays helped me a lot with grammar and composition. The exams were challenging. The course had a decent amount of homework for a language class. Our group presentations allowed us to learn more about cultures from various different Spanish speaking countries. This was a an overall positive learning experience. I would recommend to create guided notes while teaching and maybe some study guides for the exams. This course was challenging but worth it.
- The assignments and readings were always relevant not only to the class but the real world. We read articles about issues in Spanish speaking countries, but also works from famous Spanish speaking writers. I like that because even though we are learning Spanish, we have a serious gap in our Spanish literature and culture because we are just now learning to fully understand the iconic works of writing in Spanish. I feel like I learned a lot of well known pieces of Spanish writing, while also being allowed to better understand Spanish in academic contexts as well as poetic.
- The course and materials helped me improve my Spanish enormously. I became much more advanced in speaking in 16 short weeks.
