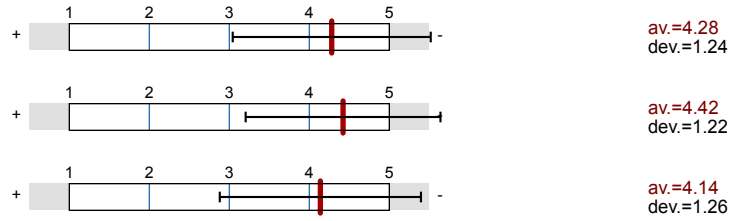

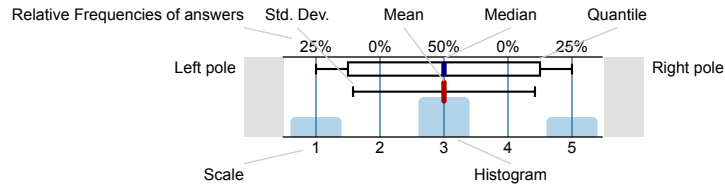

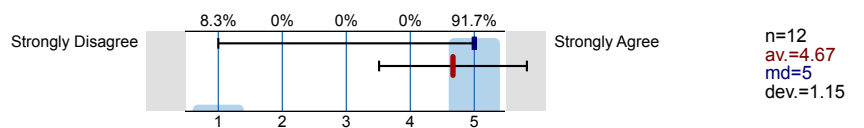

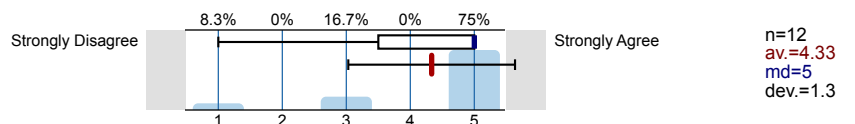

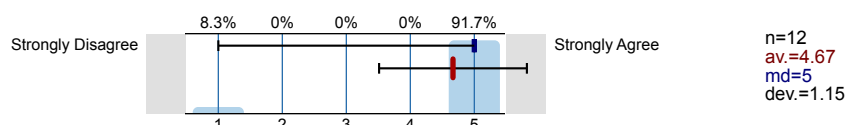

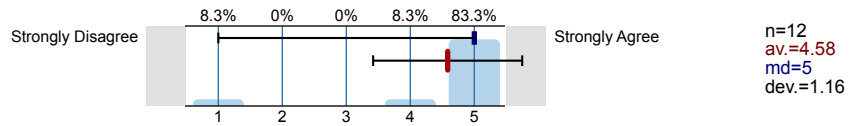

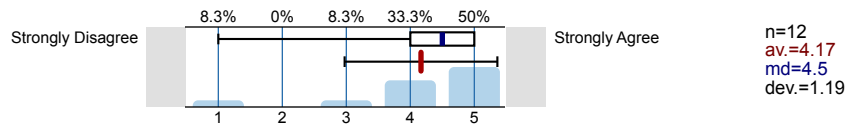

5. Open Ended

^{5.1)} The instructor (please comment on questions 4.1-4.7 above)

- Dr. Figueroa did an excellent job. She is responsible for my growing interest in Peninsular Literature. Also, thanks to her, I grew an interest in reading materials beyond class. She has the best words when it comes to giving feedback as she never discourage students. Her feedback is on point, encouraging and kind. Her class was also challenging as she thought of a way to motivate us to read the materials and actively participate in class. She was always available for feedback, grade clarification and concerns we could have. I strongly recommend her.
- Dr. Figueroa is very organized, I like how she explains the content and motivated the discussion in class.
- Dr. Figueroa is very understanding and empathetic. I'm fortunate to have had a professor like her during this time. She made me feel comfortable in class.
- Dr. Figueroa was very thoughtful and flexible considering the current circumstances, which I really appreciate. The meetings to discuss the readings were useful, but I think that having two meetings per week sometimes is not productive, and maybe it would be enough to discuss the readings weekly.
- Dra. Figueroa did a great job with her lectures in this course. They were always recorded on time and she spoke with enthusiasm and interest about the topics at hand. They also were very useful in understanding the context of the poetry and literature that we were reading.
- Even though there was no synchronous class-time, the professor was readily available do help with content or administrative issues. The feedback was always constructive and detailed as well as timely.
- I think the small groups were not so effective. It would be better if the teacher would start more engaged with the topic.
- The instructor always makes herself available and creates a great learning environment. She is passionate and cares about her students.
- The instructor was helpful and promoted discussion during class time, which helped me develop my ideas.

5.2) The course and the materials (please comment on questions 4.8-4.10 above)

- I appreciate that we read women in this class.
- I found the course structure to be perfect given the online context. There was a good quantity of assignments that kept me busy without being overwhelming. The structure of the exams has been helpful in preparing for the comprehensive exams. The structure of videos with brief overviews and the balance of theoretical articles and primary sources was helpful for processing and understanding the content.
- I like how the course was divided into different sections: poetry, theatre, and prose. It gave a broad sense of the era that we were learning about. It was also very clear what the homework was as she would send out a Blackboard announcement to everyone at the beginning of the week to get us all on the same page.
- I think it is better if the essays we have to write would be more challenging. I believe I didn't improve my investigation skills.
- My only suggestion is that the conversation group members change throughout the semester, rather than meeting with the same people every week. I believe this arrangement was made to allow for smaller groups and it was effective in that sense, but I think changing group members every few weeks would keep the conversations dynamic.
- She carefully selected the materials in order to give us a solid presentation of the Spanish Literature. Also, her quizzes and reading activities helped us learn much more in this modality. Her course is accurate to the online mode. Her materials always sparked interest.
- The course was challenging and interesting.
- The course was well-organized as an asynchronous course. The expectations and materials were well explained and the Blackboard page was well-organized.
- The materials were clear and understandable, for an introduction to Spanish literature it was good recollection.
- This course was well organized and quite interesting, and I really liked that we could read a bit of everything (prose, poetry and drama), which gave us a general overview of the period. I found the quizzes to be a bit exhausting after we did a couple of them, and maybe they could be reduced, considering that we also have the exams and short essays. The reading check can be easily done during our meetings, and it may be more productive than the quizzes.

5.3) Self-Evaluation (please comment on questions 4.11-4.16 above)

- Dr. Figueroa's feedback helped me a great deal to improve my writing, and I felt accompanied during the course, even though we were meeting online. Having regular meetings was an extra motivation to prepare for class, and I appreciate that.
- I definitely put effort into this class. I listened to all her lectures multiple times and tried to write thoughtful essays. As always, I wish I could have found the time to take advantage of her office hours to get further education about the topics.
- I felt particularly motivated in her class and I did my best. I learned great content in her course and I know that the grade that I get is the one I deserve in her course.
- I had to read a lot but it wasn't too much, so it kept being interesting without getting exhausting. I felt like I had a good grasp over the materials for this class.
- I prepared for the class every session, and I think I did a good job. However, sometimes I felt my work was not enough because my classmates were not so participative.
- I regularly attended the discussion session, completed the readings and the assignments on time. Even though my grade is lower than I would have hoped, I feel that I learned and grew much more than I expected in this class.
- This was one of my first courses about literature, I think my overall performance was good. I still have some improvements to do. But I really enjoy the class.
